Information we collect

Our school collects and records personal, sensitive and health information from children and parents/guardians before and during the course of your child's enrolment.

Purpose of collection

In addition, some of the information we collect and record is to satisfy the school's legal obligations, particularly to enable the school to carry out a duty of care for students and parents/guardians. This information may also be used for appropriate parish purposes.

Disclosure of information

This information may be disclosed by us for administrative and educational purposes to others including, but not limited to, personnel within Rockhampton Catholic Education Office, other systematic schools, medical practitioners, people providing services to school, such as specialists, visiting teachers and consultants.

If we do not obtain the personal, sensitive or health information referred to above, we may not be able to enrol or continue to enrol your child.
